## ROCK'N DOUGH WHISKEY EDUCATION

### WHISKEY CLASSIFICATIONS

#### BOURBON & AMERICAN RYE WHISKEY

- Made with a grain mixture of at least 51% corn (or Rye)
- Distilled to no more than 80% ABV
- Aged in Virgin Oak Barrels
- May not be introduced to the barrel at higher than 125 proof
- Must be produced in the United States

#### TENNESSEE WHISKEY

- Is a specific variation of bourbon made in Tennessee and has an additional set of regulations
- Must be filtered through maple charcoal chunks before aging (called Lincoln county process)

#### SCOTCH WHISKY

- Must be made of all Scottish ingredients
- Must be made with barley (Many scotches use 100% barley)
- Must be aged in Scotland for at least 3 years
- Must have an ABV lower than 94.8%
- · Usually aged in used American White Oak Barrels

#### IRISH WHISKEY

- Must be aged at least 3 years in the Republic of Ireland
- All other regulations are pretty relaxed

### WHISKEY TERMINOLOGY

#### STRAIGHT BOURBON OR RYE

To be labeled as Straight Bourbon or Rye, the liquor must meet all the previous requirements and be aged at a minimum of 2 years in Virgin American White Oak Barrels

#### BOTTLED IN BOND (BIB)

To be labeled as bottled-in-bond or bonded, the liquor must be the product of one distillation season (January–June or July–December) by one distiller at one distillery. It must have been aged in a federally bonded warehouse under U.S. government supervision for at least four years and be bottled at 100 proof. The bottled product's label must identify the distillery where it was distilled and, if different, where it was bottled. Only spirits produced in the United States may be designated as bonded.

#### **SMALL BATCH**

A small batch of Bourbon is just a few select single barrels that will undoubtedly complement and combine well as a blend of many carefully selected barrels.

#### rarrfi Proof

Bottling at the proof of the actual barrel.

#### FULL PROOF

Bottled at barrel entry proof of 125 (62.5% ABV), but it's worth remembering that this means it has been proofed down to a standard strength through the addition of water. Evap
